The School population reached a record 964 pupils.

Mr Clifford Evans, the Deputy Headmaster, is retiring after 24 years' service at Dynevor. Many generations of History pupils at Dynevor have received the benefit of his scholarly tuition and wise guidance. Mr Evans has a great capacity for detailed organisation and mature judgement. A man of high integrity, he will be missed at Dynevor.

Mr Bryn Davies, Head of the Department of Welsh, retires after 25 years at Dynevor. He has not only enriched the life of the school in his own subject, but has also given much of his time to the organisation of the Council for Education in World Citizenship. His retirement will be a great loss to staff and pupils. We wish them both a long and happy retirement.
